Sacramental Preparation Information

Baptismal certificates will be requested for all children who were not baptized at MPB. We will keep copies on file for our sacramental records.

First Reconciliation will be celebrated **Tuesday, March 5, 2018, at 6:30 PM**, followed by an Ice Cream Social. In addition to the **Parent Meeting on Sunday, January 20 (9:00 AM)**, a **Family Meeting will be held Sunday, January 27, 2018 at 9:00 AM** in the 2nd grade classroom. Sacramental preparation will be in addition to regular Faith Formation class and includes family meetings to be announced. A separate Sacramental Preparation fee of **\$25.00** will be due for each child, preparing for this sacrament (including children attending Catholic schools)+.

First Eucharist will be celebrated Sunday, June 2, 2018 at 10:30 Mass, followed by a breakfast reception. A **Parent Meeting will be held Sunday, January 20, at 9:00 AM**. Sacramental preparation will be in addition to Faith Formation class, and includes **two mini-retreats**; dates and times to be announced. A separate Sacramental Preparation Fee of **\$25.00** will be due for each child, preparing for this sacrament (including children attending Catholic schools)+.
