During the period of November 1 through December 18 we will again collect winter clothing, non-perishable foods and paper goods to assist residents in the Town of Evans. For warm clothing we will accept winter coats, gloves, boots and hats in all sizes, colors and styles. Popular items also requested include sneakers and any clothing in children's sizes. We ask that any clothing donated be clean for wear. For food we will accept dry and canned foods whose shelf life has not expired. Examples consist of soups, cereals, pasta and vegetables. Baby food is in great demand. This year there was an increase of 54% for meals served at OGN. Current programs of assistance will not provide for nonfood items such as Kleenex, paper towels, tooth brushes and toilet paper. These will be collected, also.
